

Historical Note – 80 years ago

(From the pages of "the West Australian")

"The opening of the Guilford Garrick Club for 1937 was held on the lawn of Mr H R Hillman's home at South Guildford on Tuesday evening, when a large audience of members and their friends enjoyed the presentation of three one-act plays, "The Apricot Tree" and "Square Pegs" by Clifford Bax, and A A Milne's "The Princess and the Woodcutter".

The casts included Miss Dancer and Messrs. Gibbons and Frank Johnson in "The Apricot Tree," produced by Mrs Dancer; Miss Jessie Johnson and Mrs A Todd in "Square Pegs," under Mrs Palmer's direction; and Mr Hillman produced the Milne play with Miss Betty Hillman and Mr Keith Murray in the title roles, supported by an able cast. The colourful old-world costumes and garden background made a pleasing effect."

Production Notes

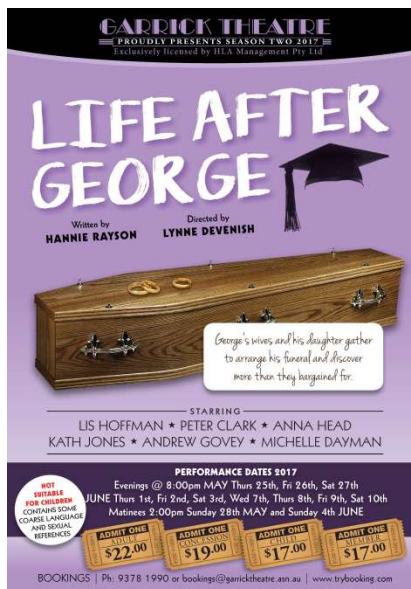
Cinderella
