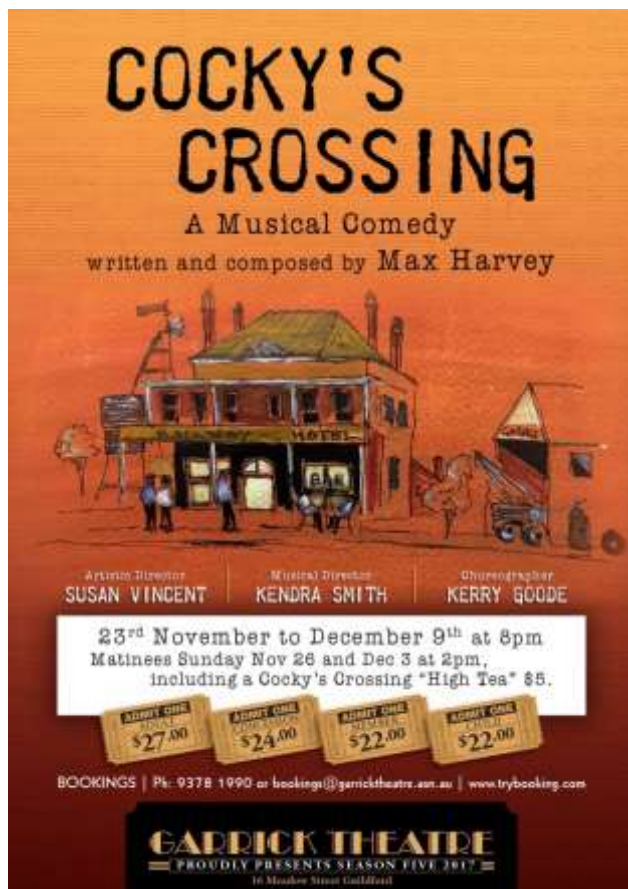
The Glass Menagerie by Tennessee Williams
