Brooke Daniels Wannabe actress- attractive seductive and oozing sensuality – will be wearing a sexy evening dress

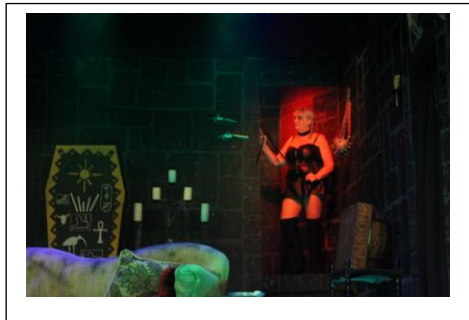
